Reference to your application dated 20.4.2017 for starting a new Homoeopathic College in the name of K L E University’s Homoeopathic College, Belagavi, Karnataka, I am directed to inform that the said application was forwarded to CCH on 25.05.2017 for inspecting the college to assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training in the college as per the required norms prescribed under section 12A of the HCC Act, 1973 and the regulations made thereunder and to furnish the recommendations. CCH inspected the said college on 20.09.2017 and vide CCH letter No. 15-5/2017-CCH (12) dated 07.11.2017, Letter of Intent (LoI) was granted to the applicant college subject to fulfilment of certain conditions.

2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, CCH has conducted the inspection of **KLE University’s Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Belagavi, Karnataka**, on 11.06.2018 and furnished the inspection report along with recommendation to the Ministry for further consideration in the matter of granting permission for the A.Y. 2018-19.

3. After careful consideration of your proposal in terms of the provision of the HCC Act, 1973 and the relevant Regulations made thereunder, inspection report of CCH and policy of the Central Government for granting conditional permission during the session 2018-19, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to **KLE University’s Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Belagavi, Karnataka**, for starting admissions in BHMS course with hundred (100) seats for the academic session 2018-19 under Section 12 A of HCC Act, 1973 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions :-



- i. that, the college administration shall ensure that sufficient qualified teaching faculty, non-teaching staff, hospital staff and other requirements as per the provision of HCC (MSR), 2013, Regulations are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1st professional BHMS course in made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCH.
 - ii. that, all the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
 - iii. that, the college shall have required number of instruments / equipment as per HCC (MSR), 2013.
4. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for 2nd, 3rd and 4th BHMS course well in time as per the CCH norms which will be verified and reported by the CCH at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent session will be issued.
5. The College administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under the Section 13(1) of the HCC act, 1973 at the time when the first batch of students admitted against this course for the final professional examination of the said course.


